Don't get cheated by E-mails/SMSs/Calls Promising you Money or Lottery

Dear Customer,

Greetings from IOB !

Have you received an Email/ SMSs/ Call informing that you have won a lottery or will get huge sums from abroad? **Or** have you been offered cheap funds for your business?

Don't believe these. They are fake.



1. Don't send money as an initial deposit/ commission/ transfer fee to any unknown party in India or abroad.
2. Don't reveal your bank account number / details or any other related information to anyone, either on phone or through email.
3. Don't enter into any correspondence with any party- Indian or foreign – in the hope of receiving any money from them.
4. Inform your friends/ family members to be careful.
5. Please inform the Cyber Cell/ other Law enforcing Agency of such fictitious offers

Do not share confidential information like Internet banking login ID /Password /OTP /PIN /ATM-Debit /Credit Card Number / CVV/ Expiry Date to anyone. If you receive a mail or phone call asking for the same, be alert, as it is likely to be from a fraudster.

Bank or its employees will never ask for such confidential information through e-mail or over phone.
